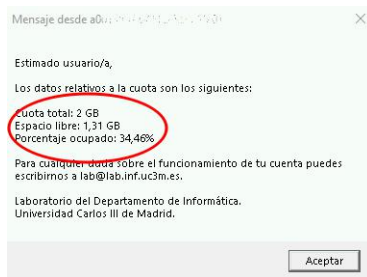


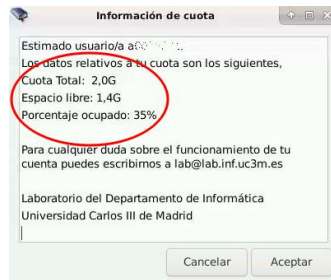
User quota information

The student account quota is 2GB in the Computer Science Department Laboratory.

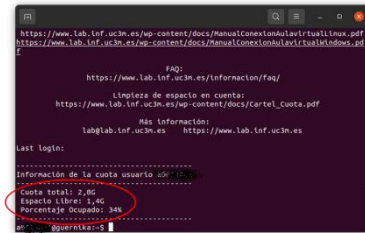
When you are logged in on a lab computer (Windows, Linux and Guernika), you can see your quota information:

Linux

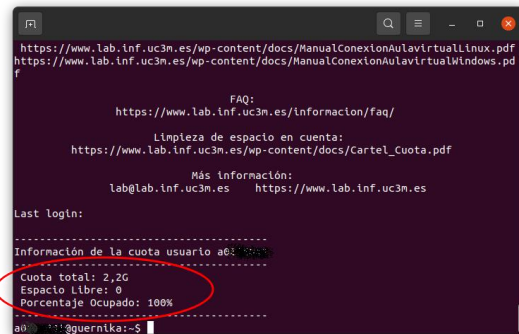


Guernika

If your quota is over 2GB, you may not be able to log in and it will be necessary accessing Guernika server to free up space in your account.

The cleaning process is detailed below:

1. Log in to **Guernika Server** (You can find more information about it in this [guide](#))
2. You will be able to check at the moment of the connection if you have enough **space available** . The system allows you to write up to **2.2GB**.
3. If you need to delete files, you can type the command **"du -h --max-depth=1"** and view your directories and their sizes. In the last line you can check total storage of your account.
4. Frequently there are a lot of unnecessary information stored in **"./.cache"** directory. You can remove this directory typing the command **"rm -fr ./cache"**.
5. There are some important directories such as **"./Documentos"**, **"./Windows"**, **"./snap"**. Carefully check their stored data and then **remove what you consider unnecessary**. For this operation you can type the the command **"rm -fr directory"** (Take care with this command, what you delete is unrecoverable)
6. **IMPORTANT!** We recommend that you do not delete these directories. **"./Maildir ./windows/escritorio ./windows/documentos ./windows"**
7. You can recheck the available space in your account with the command **"consultar_cuota.sh"**
8. When you have finished, you can close your session by typing **"exit"**
